Grades Served: Pre-K (4 years) through 8; **Student Population:** About 500.

Hours of Operation: Classes begin at 8:00 am, dismissal is at 3:00 pm, Monday–Friday;

Breakfast Served: 7:20 am – 7:50 am, Monday – Friday.

Application Process: OneApp enrollment process (*see* enrollnola.org);

Requirements: for residents of Orleans Parish, open enrollment, no academic entrance requirements;

School Uniforms: all students are required to be in school uniform daily, average costs about \$65 (*excluding shoes*); see school's website (fcws.org) for additional information regarding the school's uniform policy.

Student Support Services: school counselor, school nurse, speech pathologist, reading interventionists, part-time behavioral, dean-of-students, SPED department, paraprofessionals, itinerant staff-physical therapist, occupational therapist, adaptive physical education, gifted teacher, talented arts teacher;

Special Education Model: inclusion;

Transportation: private vendor yellow school bus.

Breakfast/Lunch Program: pupil nutrition program is provided by private vendor Fresh Food Factor, a subsidiary of Volunteers of America; breakfast is served beginning at 7:20 am daily; lunch is served daily beginning a 10:25 am to 12:30 pm (5 sessions); students may bring their breakfast or lunch, but no fast food is allowed in the school's cafeteria (due to federal law).

Before/After School Care: Due to COVID-19, there is NO before or after school care for students at the present time.

Art Education: Instrumental Music, Vocal Music, Visual Art, Gifted & Talented Art;

Enrichment Classes: Art, Instrumental Music, Vocal Music, Physical Education;

Team Sports: Flag Football (boys); Basketball (boys & girls); Volleyball (girls); Cross Country (boys & girls).
