Dear Third and Fourth Grade Parents,

The state passed a new law this school year that will affect your child. Bulletin 1565, revised October 2022, requires that third and fourth grade students who score below grade level on an end of year literacy assessment must receive 30 hours of summer literacy interventions consisting of explicit, targeted literacy instruction based on the science of reading or they will be retained. This policy is only applicable for the 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 school years only.

Fannie C. Williams Charter School 3rd and 4th grade students who score below benchmark on their final DIBELS screening, will be required to complete 30 hours of reading instruction in order to be promoted to the next grade for the 2023-2024 school year.

Fannie C. Williams Charter School in partnership with Kedila Family Learning Services will offer an in-person summer program from June 5th – June 29th to meet this requirement.

Please be sure to register your child now for the summer enrichment program to avoid them being retained in their current grade.
