NOPS determines the calendar and the procedures utilized for enrollment of all public schools in the New Orleans. To begin the process of enrolling your child at FCWCS, you must begin with the NOPS.

It contains the most current information regarding enrollment for NOLA Public Schools. The site has specific info regarding children 4 and under and students in grades kindergarten through 12. At FCWCS, we have classes for students in grades Pre-K (4 years) through 8th grade. Open enrollment usually occurs to mid-September.

The three Resource Centers should be your first stop. The addresses (West Bank, New Orleans East, and Uptown) can be found on website under Resources. Days, hours, phone numbers, and documentation needed can be found there. The site's info can be read in English, Spanish, Vietnamese, and French.

FCWCS can start the enrollment process until you have the "okay" from one of New Orleans Public Schools' Resource Center. The Resource Centers can advise you of whether our school has openings in the grade level you need for your scholar(s).

Once you have secured your spot at FCWCS, please refer to 'New Student Info' under Admissions for info to complete enrollment.
